School Responsibility:

- - To provide a challenging curriculum
 - To create a safe and pleasant environment physically and emotionally

Staff Responsibility:

Parent/ Guardian Responsibility:

- To ensure that their children attend school regularly, punctually, properly equipped and wearing school uniform.
- To make their children aware of appropriate behaviour in all situations.
- To encourage independence.
- To show an interest in all that their children do in school, and ensure that homework is completed to the highest possible standard.

- To foster good relationships with the school and make the school aware of any concerns which might affect their children's progress or behaviour.
- To be aware of the school's rules and expectations.
