Learning activities

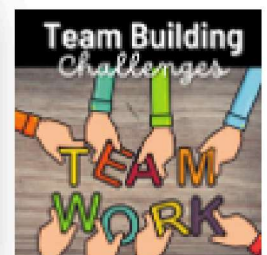
