Every donation makes a difference, however big or small.

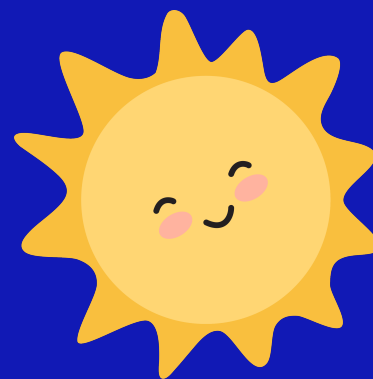
