Black History Month

This week we had another assembly linked to Black History month. We listened to the story of Ruby Bridges and discussed the consequences of hate. Ruby Bridges was a brave civil rights activist who became the first African-American student to integrate an all-white elementary school in New Orleans in 1960. On her first day at William Frantz Elementary, she was escorted by federal marshals and spent the day in the principal's office because the other students' parents pulled them out. Now an adult, she is known for her advocacy for racial tolerance and runs the Ruby Bridges Foundation.
